Energy Observer was launched in 2017 with the aim of being the first vessel to circumnavigate the globe entirely self-sufficiently thanks to renewable energies and hydrogen, without emitting any polluting emissions (fine particles, CO₂) or noise. This is innovation at the service of nature and the widest possible audience and it is the essence of a project that has enabled us to go further than we could ever have imagined. From becoming France's first ambassador for Sustainable Development Goals, to producing exclusive documentary films and creating Energy Observer Developments to push the envelope with zero-emission technologies, the project is really taking on a whole new dimension. Today, the project is about so much more than a floating laboratory, indeed it is a powerful symbol of awareness.



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From a start-up model, Energy Observer must develop a structure around a strong brand, supported by a committed, multidisciplinary team, backed by the loyal support of our partners, determined to shake things up. Our change of identity developed with the Base Design agency (an international network of studios in New York, Brussels, Geneva and Melbourne) illustrates the rapid evolution and diversification of our activities and our skill sets.

We are at the crossroads of some complementary professions: we think about change, we document it, we are a mouthpiece for green innovation among political decision-makers and manufacturers, whilst laying down a gauntlet for change by ensuring that we rank among today's movers and shakers.

The dream became a reality 4 years later, when the Energy Observer vessel was launched for the first time. Developed from a legendary multiple award-winning catamaran, Energy Observer is a laboratory for ecological transition designed to push back the limits of zero-emission technologies. Hydrogen, solar, wind and water power, all the solutions are experimented with, tested and optimised here with a view to making clean energies a practical reality that is accessible to all.

Criss-crossing the oceans in a bid to get out and meet those who are coming up with sustainable solutions for the planet every day, Energy Observer has become a movement, a round the world Odyssey, where every stopover is an opportunity to learn, to understand and to share the different energies.
